- Begin working on application resume.

### OCTOBER

- Complete financial aid forms.
- Polish college application essay.
- Finalize list of schools.

### NOVEMBER

- Apply early. Prepare to submit applications in advance of deadlines.
- Clean up social media accounts.
- Apply for scholarships for high school seniors.

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### DECEMBER

- Follow up with teachers and counselors regarding recommendations.
- Send test scores and transcripts to colleges.
- Submit all college applications before winter break.

### DECEMBER

- Confirm all schools have received transcripts, test scores, recommendations, and financial aid forms.
- Submit applications to colleges with late deadlines.

### JANUARY

Continue to apply for scholarships.

### FEBRUARY

Continue to apply for scholarships.

### MARCH

- Start searching for a job or internship for the summer.
- Think about graduation party ideas.
- Order graduation announcements/ invitations.
- Order cap and gown.

### APRIL

- Choose colleges.
- Mail graduation announcements and/or graduation party invitations.

### MAY

- Write Thank-you notes for recommendations.
- Write thank you notes as graduation gifts arrive.
- Research housing options for the fall.
